We invite you to a fantastic tour through Spain to discover the food and wines and visit some of the most outstanding Catholic shrines.

Our Tour will start in Bilbao, on **Sunday, August 25th**, with the departure of all from the US. (Flight arrives Monday, August 26th)

In Bilbao we will visit the massive Guggenheim Museum and



eat at one of the famous Michelin star restaurants of the Basque Country. After a day exploring Bilbao, we will move on to the Rioja Wine Region where we will try the most famous wines of Spain.

Our next stop is Ribera del Duero where we will be able to visit Caleruega, the village where St. Dominic, the founder of the Dominican Order was born, and we will be able to attend Mass there. And of course, try the also exceptional wines from Ribera del Duero.



Then we will move on to the less known wine region of Toro, with wine tastings in Zamora and other cities. An overnight stop in the Parador de Santo Estevo in the Ribera Sacra will show you the beauty of this rather unknown wine region. From there we will move to another highlight of the trip, the city of Santiago de Compostela. We will have a chance to walk for a bit on the famous path leading to the city and also try wines from the Galicia region.

A short flight on Wednesday morning, will take us to Madrid, Spain's capital and here we will visit the Royal Basilica of Our Lady of Atocha, and a few other sights of this wonderful city. Thursday morning all parties depart from Madrid airport.
